The Board There are 7 members on the AAI Board. Chairperson: Orlaith Traynor




**Domestic Adoption** Since 1952, there have been over 45,000 domestic adoptions



**International Adoption** There have been over 5,000 international adoptions into Ireland


Children have been adopted into Ireland from over 27 different countries since 1991

### **Information and Tracing**


National Adoption Contact Preference Register (NACPR): Established in 2005, this is a register to make connections and share information between adopted people and their families.
